Drusilla

Secondary School and Teacher Training



When we met Drusilla Tembo in 2008 she was living with her mother, six siblings and her cousin in a converted chicken house in the suburbs of Kitwe. Before Drusilla's father died they lived in the main house, but now they are forced to rent it out in order to survive.

Drusilla told us, "I passed my grade 9 exams in 2005. In 2006 I started at Mukuba High School. At that time I had no-one to pay for my school fees." She talked to the contact teacher responsible for overseeing the Cecily's Fund supported children at her school. The contact teacher put her in touch with Cecily's Fund who agreed to pay her school fees. "I was very happy and very thankful. If not for that help I would have had to try to borrow the money from someone and pay it back little by little when I was working..."

We are now supporting Drusilla to train as a science teacher at Mufilira College. This will help her to qualify for a secure government teaching job which will enable her to contribute towards her family's upkeep.
