

Paul – Primary School

Paul is 10 years old. His mother died in 2005. His father then remarried, but his new wife did not want Paul and his four brothers. The boys then went to live with their grandmother but she was unable to care for them. Paul's father died in 2008 in a road accident. The boys now live in a four roomed house and survive by renting out two rooms in the house, a shop at the front and growing their own vegetables.

We are supporting Paul and his immediate older brother at primary school. Paul is in grade 2 and his brother is in grade 4.

Elder brother, Rayton told us, "Things have been really tough since our mother died four years ago and since our grandmother left us last year. At least now my younger brothers can go to school. This has lightened my burden. They need to go to school to have a chance in life".

Paul's contact teacher told us that Paul is doing very well in school, particularly in mathematics.
